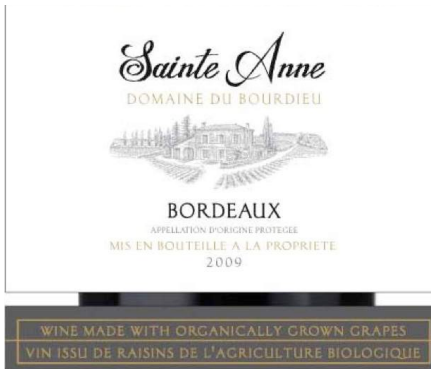




Domaine Sainte Anne 2010 Entre-Deux-Mers White

Golden white reflections show the fully mature grapes in this wine. Aromas of exotic fruits with citrus, mango white peach and lychee. A fresh, lively attack balances these aromas with a touch of minerality. The palate is complex, with long, harmonious flavors.



Domaine Sainte Anne 2009 Bordeaux Red

Lively and bright clarity, with deep ruby reflections. Initial aromas of red fruits and almonds. As it opens, the nose reveals toasty, vanilla-toned notes of prune and leather, with a spicy imprint of thyme and herbes de provence. Fully present on the pallet, the wine impresses with its roundness, charm and balance. Ripe, fully integrated tannins assure a long and harmonious evolution.

The Boudon vineyard has been certified organic since 1963 and was the first organic vineyard in the Bordeaux region.
