This beautiful wine has a ruby jewel color at its edges with a deep, dark red core. When you lift the glass to your nose you will get hints of dark cherry, raspberry and bramble, leading to aromas of sweet vanilla, mocha powder, spice and cracked black pepper. Your first sip will reward you with baked blackberry pie, hints of plum and raspberry preserves. The wine fills the mid-palate with red fruit and touches of mineral, framed by nice creamy acids. The finish is long and lingering and completes this wonderful example of Mendocino County at its finest.
